The following corrections may be applied to the SCOSTA specifications version 1.2a dated March 15, 2002

1. Page 7 (section 4.4).
The following sentence may be added at the end of the section 4.4 (just before the section 4.5).

“Further, algorithm reference 1 also refers to the 3DES. No other values for the algorithm reference are defined in this standard.”

2. Section 6.2.11 Reset Retry Counter command. The explanatory notes may be modified as the following.

*“**Explanatory notes:** The command will modify a record in the EF1 subject to the interface device proving the knowledge of the reference data through a VERIFY command successfully completed earlier. If the resetting code is provided, the retry counter is set to minimum of the resetting code and Max retry count. If the resetting code is not provided, the retry counter is set to the Max retry count. The resetting code will be one byte.”*
